



# ENGAGEMENT CHARTER: EXTRACTIVES COMPANIES

## 1 Why we work for extractive private sector companies

2. **Thorough due diligence:** We are committed to supporting ethical actors and will conduct due diligence on our extractives private sector clients. We are committed to conducting a thorough due diligence process on private sector clients.
3. **Keeping governance and private sector work separate:** We will not pursue or accept contracts with extractives private sector companies that involves work that conflicts or may conflict with our work for governments. We are committed to providing impartial advice to government beneficiaries.
4. **Monitoring of experts:** We will ensure our experts divulge any conflict of interest and ensure these are considered in designing roles and responsibilities. Private sector experience is valuable, however working in parallel for a private sector client can be problematic. As a company we ensure we review any conflict of interest prior to proposing or/and contracting consultants.
5. **Anti-corruption:** We are strictly opposed to any form of corruption or fraud. We will not engage in projects that are in any way linked to unethical practices and will oppose bribery conducted in connection with our projects.
